Is the experience seasonal/date bound or subject to weather conditions?	The Round Tower will be open depending on weather conditions and staffing. Visitors must arrive at the Cathedral/Tower at least 30 minutes before closing to avoid disappointment.
Is there a minimum or maximum group booking size? Do all group bookings require advance booking?	Group tickets are for more than 10 persons. All group visits must be booked in advance. If a cathedral guide is requested, this must be indicated at the time of booking. A cathedral guide will not be available if one is not requested at the time of booking. Guided tours are not available between 12.30pm and 2.30pm. 12-person limit for Tower climb(large groups will be divided).
Is there a minimum age requirement?	There is a height restriction to climb the Tower. Children must be 140cm or taller to climb.
Mobility Limitations	The Cathedral is wheelchair accessible. Toilet facilities are not wheelchair accessible. For the Tower, you have to have a level of fitness to climb the 121 steps to the top. The Tower will not suit any person that suffers from claustrophobia.
Are there coach and car parking facilities onsite or nearby?	No parking available at Cathedral, so allow time for parking on Dean Street or in city centre car parks. 10 normal cars can park on Dean Street.
